limited to gloves, safety glasses, face-neck shields, arm sleeves, safety vests, etc.

Purging Guidelines

Follow these suggested procedures with PurgePacks[™] to Simplify the Purging Process and Save.

- Step 1: Maintain processing profile for resin in the machine and empty the barrel and screw of residual resin.
- Step 2: Clean feed throat and hopper of any contaminates. Dump or vacuum. Do not reach into feed throat opening for any reason!
- Step 3: Adjust machine profiles for the resin required for the next job.

PurgePacks™ Usage Chart

Use 1 ounce of PurgePacks[™] for every 1 inch of screw diameter (1 inch=25.4 mm)

<u>INCH</u>		PurgePacks™	<u>MM</u>		PurgePacks™
1 in.	=	1 oz.	25.4mm	=	1 oz.
1.5in.	=	2 oz.	38.1mm	=	2 oz.
2 in.	=	2 oz.	50.8mm	=	2 oz.
2.5in.	=	3 oz.	63.5mm	=	3 oz.
3 in.	=	3 oz.	76.2mm	=	3 oz.
3.5in	=	4 oz.	88.9mm	=	4 oz.
4 in.	=	4 oz.	101.6mm	=	4 oz.

- Step 4: Once the machine is ready, place PurgePacks™ directly into the hopper and follow with enough resin you are going to run next to fill the barrel. (with applications that require more than one PurgePacks™, place one PurgePacks™ into the hopper and follow with a small amount of resin and repeat until entire dosage has been added- then charge the barrel with resin).
- Step 5: Make certain that the screw is in the forward position and add enough resin to flush the barrel of any residue and resin appears natural and clean.
- Step 6: Purging Process is Complete, resume with standard procedures for next job.
